



2019 Scholarship Application Packet

Assemblies of God Credit Union (AGCU) will be awarding five (5) scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 each to graduating high school seniors who are members of AGCU and will attend an accredited college, university or vocational school in the fall. Additionally, the Merrell K. Cooper Memorial Scholarship for \$1,000 will be awarded. All scholarships are non-renewable.

AGCU is committed to higher education and young adults. This scholarship program is our way of thanking our youth account members who have chosen Assemblies of God Credit Union as their financial institution.

Students must meet the following criteria to be eligible:

- Must be a member of AGCU (student is primary account holder in good standing)
- Must be a graduating high school senior
- Must attend an accredited college, university or vocational school in the fall of graduation year

To apply for a scholarship, complete the entire application packet, which includes:

- Application form w/photo (page 2)
- List of activities, honors, awards, work experience, leadership roles, etc. (page 2)
- Official high school transcript
- Three sealed letters of recommendation (please list on page 3)
 - Two academic references (teachers, administrators, counselors, etc.)
 - One character reference (pastor, youth pastor, employer, etc.)
- Essay (see page 3 for essay topic and instructions)
- Release form (page 4)

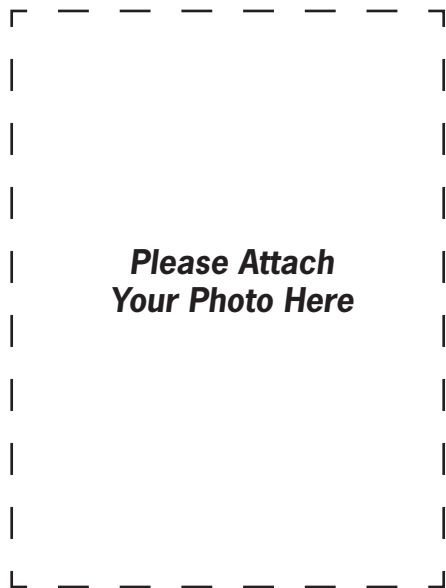
